Tasking Meeting

Once a month officers from Balsall Heath Police Station will lead a community tasking meeting alternating between Montgomery School and the Saffron Centre. The meetings will give the community the opportunity to come and discuss issues/ concerns they have within their local community. As well as the police being present at the meeting we will also be inviting local council members, housing associations, local forums and other outside agencies who might benefit from attending.

The meetings are designed to give you, the local community, the opportunity to voice your views and to ensure that we are targeting the issues that most affect you. At each meeting priorities will be agreed upon by the community and Police. These priorities will then be distributed to local officers to action in time for the next monthly meeting, so for example if a priority was set for anti-social behaviour on a particular street, the police would have to show evidence of work to demonstrate what action has been taken to combat the issue.

However to achieve this it is imperative that the local community comes together and works in harmony with the police to ensure that the area in which we live and work becomes and remains a safe place.
