At Friendship Care and Housing we provide a number of residential services for people with either a learning disability or people experiencing mental ill health. These services are located in Rugby, Bedworth and Nuneaton. The properties that we have registered with the Commission for social care inspection vary from individual flats, two bedded bungalows to three and four bedded houses for those people who may prefer more company.

Shared properties

Within the shared properties each person will have their own fully furnished room. You will have the opportunity to be involved in the redecoration of your bedroom and in consultation with your house mates the rest of the property when redecoration is needed. There will be shared access to a kitchen, lounge or lounge diner, bathroom and well kept gardens. You will have your own key and your privacy will be respected by the staff team and where appropriate the other people you might be living with. As it is your home we are keen that, if you wish, you have friends and family visit. We can provide support or privacy whichever is required. In shared accommodation you do have to be respectful of your housemates.

Support

We provide quality housing with twenty-four hour support provided by a highly trained and committed team of staff. We offer support as required in all areas of a person's life.

- ▲ Daily living skills, cooking, cleaning, budgeting etc

- ▲ Personal care
- ▲ Increasing confidence where needed
- ▲ Accessing and attending college and / or work
- ▲ Making friends
- ▲ Leisure, the theatre, the pub, bowling, rambling etc
- ▲ Medication

There may be many other areas where support has been identified. We will work with you, your social worker or community psychiatric nurse to assess how we can meet your needs.

If it has been agreed that we can offer appropriate support we will work with you and those people important to you to help make the move as comfortable as possible. You will have a key worker who along with the staff team will get to know you well and learn how to support you appropriately.

After six weeks we will arrange a meeting to make sure that you are happy with your new home and the support offered as well as to ensure that we feel we can meet your needs. Meetings will then occur every three to six months to ensure that all remains well and that you, the people important to you and fch continue to see that the service offered is needed.

For some people the move into residential care may be a short term move. Where skills and confidence are developed until a person is ready to move into more
