We provide a complete package of accommodation and support to young women and mothers.

Aim of the service

The aim of both services is to provide supported short term assured tenancies, to young women who are aged between 16 – 25 and homeless in need of support and are pregnant or have up to two children under the age of five.

Emphasis is placed upon helping the young women to be as independent as possible and helping them gain the skills they need to look after themselves competently and with confidence.

Support is offered around life skills, budgeting, independent living skills and maintaining a tenancy. Support can also be offered around education and training, health issues and providing the skills to access services in the community.

Application for accommodation

Referrals can be made over the telephone although an application form will need to be completed. Applicants will be invited to an informal interview. The decision to offer a tenancy will be made by a multi-disciplinary panel on the basis of greatest need. The interviews will be conducted as soon as possible after the referral has been made and there will be an opportunity to see the flats at this time.

Admission criteria

- ▲ Women aged 16 – 25 years (Cartland Road).
- ▲ Women aged 16 – 25 years and over six months Pregnant or have up to two children up to the age of five. (Anderton Park Road).
- ▲ Applicants must be claiming or eligible for benefits and be able to provide proof of this.
- ▲ Applicants must be willing to participate in a programme of support, to enable them to move on after a specific time (usually up to 2 years).
